


1: PREPARING FRONT STAKE POCKET

A. Using a utility knife, carefully cut out front stake pocket and remove plastic piece.



2: INSTALLING SIDE RAIL

A. Position middle flange of pocket bracket toward outside of box. Loop cord around extended threads on pocket bracket. Route cord through slot in side rail, then tie knot at top of cord.




2: INSTALLING SIDE RAIL (Continued)

B. Lift side rail and insert pocket bracket into stake pocket.



C. Move cord until pocket bracket lines up with stake pocket. Pull cord tight and place side rail on bed rail.



- D. Turn hex bolt and flat washer into pocket bracket until finger tight.
- E. Refer to standard instructions to install side rail to front stake pocket.
- F. Repeat Steps 1-2 to install side rail on opposite side.
- G. For remaining topper installation, refer to standard instructions.
